

## **Blended/Virtual WBL Activities/Engagement**

1. Career Planning Tool that district is using to update career interest.
2. Industry Certifications – CRC and any that is relevant to POS
3. Digital Platform Job Interviews with industry partners with feedback sheets (working parents may also be willing to help with this).
4. Digital Platform Job Interviews being the interviewer with feedback sheets.
5. Professional skill development – email writing, phone etiquette, office etiquette, digital platforms (Zoom, Teams, Google hangout, etc.)
6. Industry Virtual Tours with locate partners and/or Nepris.
7. Virtual Safety Training
8. Company Trainings, if permission is granted
9. Connect student with industry partner for a 6-9 week project with sustained industry feedback points along the way. At the end of project, have a product or document completed for industry partner they can use.
10. Virtual Career Fair that may last a week with various career paths. Invite parents to present on their career.
11. Simulation through B.E. Publishing, Knowledge Matters, Stock Market Game, simulated classroom labs with industry partner engagement, etc.
12. Research company to understare what they provide, their vision, and their policies. Have students to present on the companies.
13. Skilled traded – virtual training videos.
14. Agri – virtual training videos for a project.
15. Align courses/training needs for a specific pathway with technology institutes, DOL apprenticeships, four-year colleges, and two-year colleges.
16. Writing stories for local newspaper or newsletter for industry.
17. Set up health care projects: Example set up emergency room for COVID patients and non-COVID patients.
